

# Criteria for Obtaining a CMAA Leadership Fund

## *Leadership Funds to AMAA Meetings*

### Criteria for County Alliance Members:

- Must apply for the scholarship.
- Must attend all sessions of the meeting.
- Must be a member of the AMAA, the CMAA and on the board of the local county Alliance.
- His/her local county does not provide compensation for the meeting, counties are encouraged to budget money for leadership meetings.
- Maximum lifetime compensation per person is \$500
- Must fill out the evaluation and reimbursement forms prior to receiving the scholarship
- Attend one CMAA meeting or regional conference

### Criteria for Members-at-Large:

- Must apply for the scholarship.
- Must attend all sessions of the meeting.
- Must be a member of the AMAA and of the CMAA
- Maximum lifetime compensation per person is \$500
- Must fill out the evaluation and reimbursement forms prior to receiving the scholarship
- Attend one state meeting or regional conference

### Criteria for State Board Members:

- Must apply for the scholarship and must be first time participant
- Must attend all sessions of the meeting.
- Must be a member of the AMAA, the CMAA and on the CMAA board of directors or board of directors of the local county

Alliance.

- His/her local county does not provide full compensation for the meeting.
- Maximum lifetime compensation per person is \$500
- Must fill out the evaluation and reimbursement forms prior to receiving the scholarship
- Attend two state board meetings

### *Leadership Funds to CMAA Meetings:*

#### Criteria for County Alliance Members:

- Must apply for the scholarship.
- Must attend all sessions of the meeting.
- Must be a member of the CMAA
- His/her local county does not provide full compensation for the meeting.
- Maximum lifetime compensation per person is \$300 (maximum \$150 per meeting)
- Must fill out the evaluation and reimbursement forms prior to receiving the scholarship

#### Criteria for Members-at-Large:

- Must apply for the scholarship.
- Must attend all sessions of the meeting.
- Must be a member of the CMAA
- Maximum lifetime compensation per person is \$300 (maximum \$150 per meeting)
- Must fill out the evaluation and reimbursement forms prior to receiving the scholarship.

#### Criteria for State Board Members:

- Must apply for the scholarship.
- Must attend all sessions of the meeting.

- Must be a member of the AMAA, the CMAA and on the CMAA board of directors or board of directors of the local county Alliance
- His/her local county does not provide full compensation for the meeting.
- Maximum lifetime compensation per person is \$300 (maximum \$150 per meeting)
- Must fill out the evaluation and reimbursement forms prior to receiving the scholarship.

**CMAA Conferences/Meetings/Retreats:**

Members of the Executive Board, Board of Directors, Board Development Committee, Committee/Task groups and attendees of official CMAA meetings are eligible for travel reimbursement. Attendance at all meetings is mandatory in order to receive reimbursement unless cleared in advance by the Chief Financial Officer &/or Treasurer in consultation with the Chair of the Board, and communicated to the person responsible for keeping the CMAA books.
