

Criteria for Obtaining a CMAA Scholarship Fund

Scholarship to AMAA Meetings

- Criteria for County Alliance Members
 - Must apply for the scholarship and be first time participant.
 - Must attend all sessions of the meeting and turn in meeting evaluation prior to receiving the scholarship.
 - Must be a member of the AMAA, the CMAA and on the board of the local county Alliance.
 - His/her local county does not provide compensation for the meeting, counties are encouraged to budget money for leadership meetings.
 - Maximum lifetime compensation per person is \$500
 - Attend one CMAA meeting or regional conference
- Criteria for Members-at-Large
 - Must apply for the scholarship and must be first time participant.
 - Must attend all sessions of the meeting and turn in meeting evaluation prior to receiving the scholarship.
 - Must be a member of the AMAA and of the CMAA
 - Maximum lifetime compensation per person is \$500
 - Attend one state meeting or regional conference
- Criteria for State Board Members
 - Must apply for the scholarship and must be first time participant
 - Must attend all sessions of the meeting and turn in meeting evaluation prior to receiving the scholarship.
 - Must be a member of the AMAA, the CMAA and on the CMAA board of directors or board of directors of the local county Alliance.
 - His/her local county does not provide full compensation for the meeting.
 - Maximum lifetime compensation per person is \$500
 - Attend two state board meetings

Scholarship to CMAA Meetings

- Criteria for County Alliance Members
 - Must apply for the scholarship.
 - Must attend all sessions of the meeting and turn in meeting evaluation prior to receiving the scholarship.
 - Must be a member of the CMAA
 - His/her local county does not provide full compensation for the meeting.
 - Maximum lifetime compensation per person is \$300 (maximum \$150 per meeting)
- Criteria for Members-at-Large
 - Must apply for the scholarship.
 - Must attend all sessions of the meeting and turn in meeting evaluation prior to receiving the scholarship.
 - Must be a member of the CMAA
 - Maximum lifetime compensation per person is \$300 (maximum \$150 per meeting)
- Criteria for State Board Members
 - Must apply for the scholarship.
 - Must attend all sessions of the meeting and turn in meeting evaluation prior to receiving the scholarship.

- Must be a member of the AMAA, the CMAA and on the CMAA board of directors or board of directors of the local county Alliance
- His/her local county does not provide full compensation for the meeting.
- Maximum lifetime compensation per person is \$300 (maximum \$150 per meeting)
